## **Degree Path and Requirements:**

The Accounting, Associate in Arts Degree includes 39 - 41 program units and 21 - 22 LACCD General Education Requirements units. Three units of program course CIS101 may be double-counted toward LACCD General Education Requirements area D2.

This map is a suggested term-by-term sequence of courses to complete the program in a recommended time frame. This is an efficient and recommended plan, but actual plans may vary by individual student need. This map cannot replace a meeting with <u>counselors</u>. Students can apply for certificates as soon as the necessary courses are completed. Meet with a counselor and the financial aid office to ensure continued financial aid. #### **Program Description**

This program is designed for the student who wishes to become an accountant, or to do accounting work of an advanced and technical nature in public or private accounting.

#### **Career and Transfer Opportunities**

The Accounting, Associate in Arts degree prepares students to transfer to a four-year institution or to enter the accounting profession. Positions in accounting include accounting clerk, payroll clerk, management accountant, auditor, controller, tax preparer, and Certified Public Accountant (CPA). In the accounting profession, CPA licensure in the State of California requires a Baccalaureate degree and 150 semester units. Information on the educational requirements for CPA licensure can be found in here. Median annual earnings range from \$46,000 to \$74,700 based on job title.

Visit the <u>Transfer Center</u> for transfer information, which varies based on transfer college. Make an appointment with a <u>counselor</u>. Students can visit <u>Career and Job Services</u> for career counseling and further exploration.
