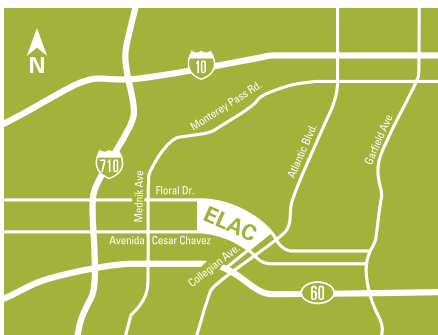

Carrasco attended West Los Angeles College and then transferred to UCLA where she received a BFA in art. She holds an MFA from the California Institute of the Arts.

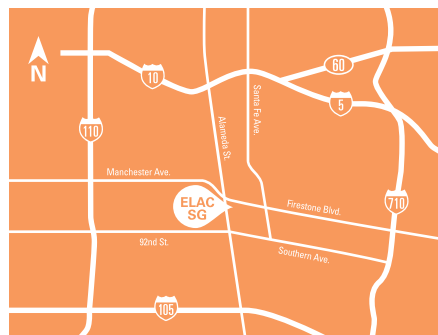

ELAC students are rapidly adjusting to the happy reality of attending classes in our magnificent Performing and Fine Arts Center buildings. The state-of-the-art \$65 million complex allows our music, dance, theater and fine arts faculty to expand their classes, highlight student creativity and nurture student achievements. The three buildings, surrounded by a number of patios and informal seating areas, are a natural gathering space intended to stimulate collaboration between the performing and visual arts. We expect the arts center to contribute to the development of a vibrant college art community that will benefit our students and the surrounding cities.

We have also streamlined registration and admissions services for our students. The new Student Services Center, with a distinctive clock tower, centralizes all processes students need to complete to enroll in classes. The adjacent parking structure and companion administration building and conference center facilitates access to the college.

As student life develops using these new facilities, it is easy to imagine how construction projects still underway on campus will alter and enrich our academic and career programs. These projects will continue to enhance campus access to technology and instructional capacity. But until more buildings come on line, we are celebrating a milestone—the addition of more than 240,000 sq. ft. of instructional and academic support space to the ELAC campus.

The heart of an institution is its people. This is especially true of East Los Angeles College. People count. Usually the two reasons students select ELAC is location—the campus is convenient to more than 1.5 million homes—and is the best educational value in the community. But once students start attending classes, ELAC’s instructors become the primary reason they return semester after semester to complete their education.

ELAC professors are committed to teaching students how to learn and problem solve. The classroom experience is enhanced by a comprehensive network of support services that assist underprepared students to succeed: students have access to hundreds of computers in the writing center, math and science tutoring programs and classrooms; non-credit programs help students prepare for college-level coursework; and many student clubs and organizations provide supportive peer groups that enhance the ELAC experience.

Additional student services include excellent counseling and financial aid assistance, active university transfer and career centers, child care, student government and special-interest clubs, and excellent physical education and athletic programs. You will belong at ELAC if you take the first step to connect with our fine programs and services.

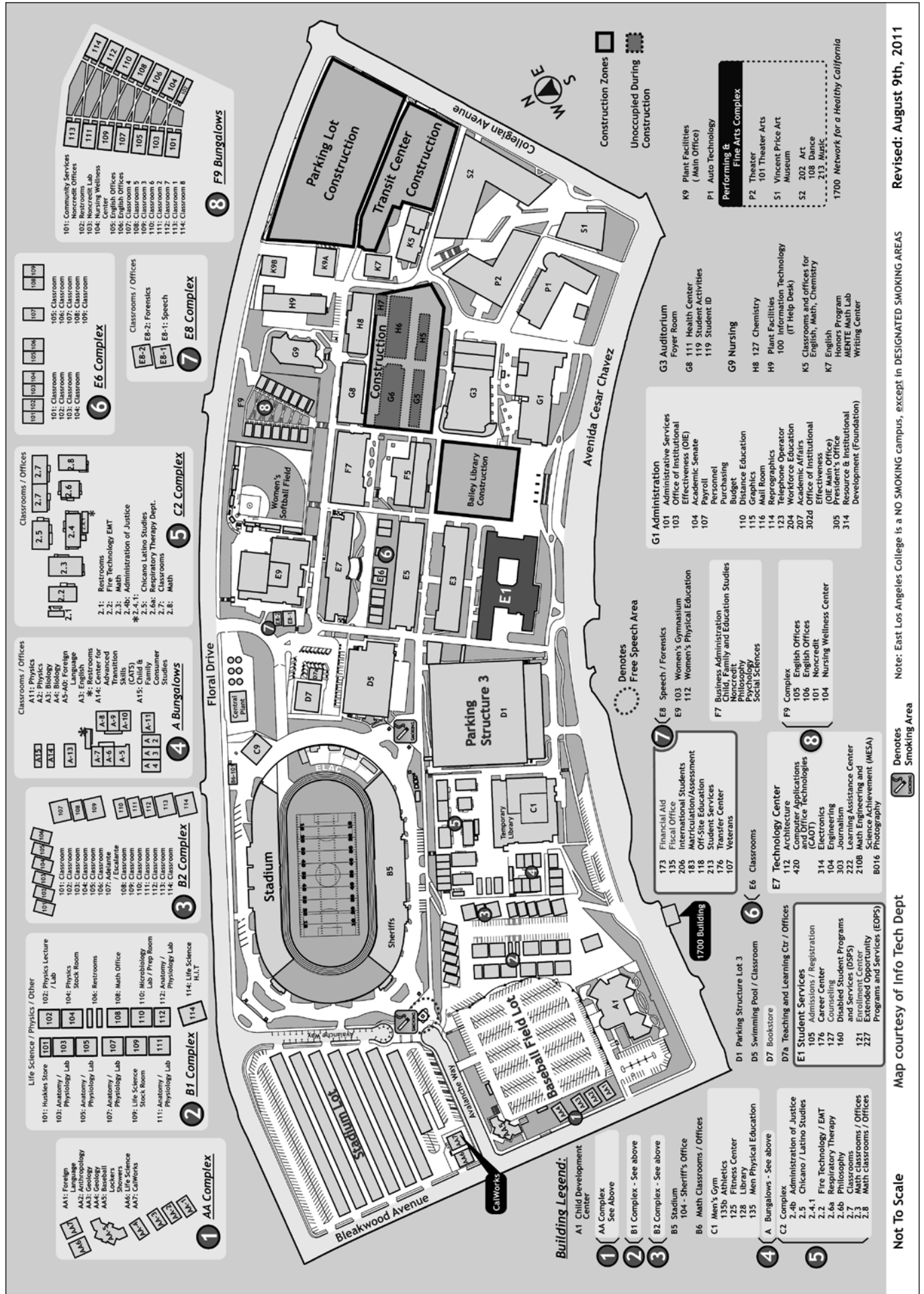
