The Scholarship Foundation of the College Women's Club of Pasadena (CWC) is pleased to enclose an application form for its fellowship and scholarship awards for the year 2012-2013. The awards will range from \$3,000 to \$5,000 each.

The deadline for application submissions is February 1, 2012. We ask that you post the application form on your college website. This will make it easier for students to apply. Former CWC award recipients who will be seniors or graduate students are eligible to apply for a second award; and they must also submit all paperwork and transcripts.

**Each applicant is to submit the following to support her application:**

- **Official Transcript reflecting a Cumulative GPA of 3.2 or above**
- **Full-time Enrollment**
- **Proof of Citizenship (if not US born)**
- **Letter of Reference**
- **Personal Essay**

Applications are to be sent to the post office box shown on the application form. The CWC Fellowship/Scholarship Committee will review and select the awardees. **Notification of the awards will be sent in April, 2012. The Awards Luncheon will take place on the first Tuesday in May, 2012.** Each recipient, along with her guest and a member of the Financial Aid Office will be invited to attend.

**The award will be issued in two equal payments – one half for the 2012 Fall Semester or Quarter, after the College Women's Club receives proof by way of the Registrar that the student is enrolled on a full-time basis; and the second half after the student submits verification of full-time enrollment in a subsequent semester (e.g. winter, spring or summer 2012-2013).**

Thank you so very much for helping us undertake this endeavor. From past responses we have received, we know the CWC scholarships are invaluable to students.
