- **CAFÉ Coalition report on Monterey Park Activities and putting a stop to smoking working alongside of Respiratory Therapy Club. Ask for support for final vote in Monterey Park City Council for Prop 29 and second reading for ordinance**

#### **V. ACTION ITEMS**

##### **A. Charter Clubs**

**Respiratory Therapy Club presents their mission statement. Motion to charter this club is put to a vote and passes unanimously**

**B. Match Fund Geology Club- Vice President Shakira Eguez moves to postpone this action item until the end of the meeting to and her motion is seconded by Chief Delegate Estrada. Motion is put to a vote and passes unanimously**

##### **C. Match Fund Pep Squad**

**Match fund Pep Squad in the amount of \$1800.25 action item is moved by Vice President Eguez and is seconded by Chief Delegate Estrada. Match Funding is explained by Chief Delegate Estrada in order to clear up extra money left over issues. Vice President Eguez finishes the conversation by asking about their fundraising issues. Motion is put to a vote and passes unanimously. A cheer is asked to be performed, it is denied.**

**D. Fund Engineering Club- ASU had Approved this item BAC approval was needed**

**E. Fund Di Composer Club in the amount of \$500- Vice President Eguez moved to discuss this item and was seconded by Commissioner of Journalism Isaac Tovar. President James Garcia explains this item was presented since they had asked for a loan in the past meeting and turned it into a community event instead, however this item was already approved in the previous meeting by ASU and only needed BAC approval. Motion to strike item E. from the record was put to a vote and passed unanimously**

**F. Fund Economic Student Association Stock Market Prize in the amount of \$213- motion is moved by Vice President Eguez. The original amount was \$426 and was lowered by BAC. Motion to postpone item until the end of the meeting since ESA Club is not present was made by Chief Delegate Estrada and seconded by Vice President Eguez.**

**G. Fund Economic Student Association Banquet. President Garcia asks if there are any objections to skip item since it follows the same principles as item F. Since there are no Objections officers proceed to next item.**

**H. Fund Respiratory Therapy Club- Item is skipped since it only needed BAC Approval.**

**I. Fund Kung Fu Club in the amount of \$900- Vice President Eguez moves item and is seconded by Chief Delegate Estrada. Club members explain that they noticed price was more expensive**

than expected. Chief Delegate and Vice President explain that they need proper maintenance in order to keep the equipment clean and neat. Motion is put to a vote and passes unanimously.

Chief Delegate motions to entertain item B. Match Fund Geology Club in the amount of \$420- and is seconded by Vice President Eguez.

B. Match fund Geology Club in the amount of \$420 – motion is moved by Commissioner of Journalism and is seconded by Senator of Health and Safety Gonzalez. Motion is put to a vote and passes.

- Match Fund Puente Club in the amount of \$1840 – Vice President Eguez moves to discuss this item and is seconded by Chief Delegate Estrada. Chief Delegate moves to amend the amount asked for to \$2000 and is seconded by Vice President Eguez. Motion to raise the amount is put to a vote and passes unanimously. Motion to Match Fund \$2000 to ELAC’s Puente Club
- Match Fund AFFF Banquet for Club Volunteers in the amount of \$434.54 moved by Vice President Eguez and is seconded by Chief Delegate Estrada. Motion is put to a vote and passes.
- Match Fund M N M’s Club in the amount of \$308.75- motion is moved to discussion by Vice President Eguez and is seconded by Commissioner of Administration of Justice Alonzo. Motion is put to a vote and passes unanimously.

that this has been passed through BAC and just needed a correction in ASU. Motion is put to a vote and passes unanimously.

**M. Fund Compensation for Graduation Volunteers in the amount of \$175- motion is moved by Vice President Eguez and was seconded by Commissioner of Administration of Justice Alonzo. Motion is put to a vote and passes unanimously.**

**N. Fund Purchase of Scantron Ballots- \$500 motion is moved by Chief Delegate Estrada and is seconded by Commissioner of Journalism Tovar. Motion passes with a unanimous vote.**

**O. Fund Purchase of Poster Paper in the amount of \$2200- motion is moved by Chief Delegate Estrada and is seconded by Commissioner of Journalism. Motion is put to a vote and passes unanimously**
