Exemption Application for Club Charter Candidates with Over 80 Units

(Student Regulation 9 Section 1-a Exemption)

In accordance with S9 section 1-a (Eligibility for Associated Student Organization Offices), an ASU candidate or officer must have successfully completed no more than 80 degree-applicable units in the District. Exceptions on the maximum unit requirement for this regulation may be made for students enrolled in a college degree, certificate or transfer program where the combination of program requirements and prerequisites may result in the student exceeding the 80 degree-applicable unit limit.

Per S9 section 1-f requirements, "An officer may serve a fifth semester if eligible at the time of assuming office with the approval of the college president or designee" and must satisfy one of the following requirements:

- 1) The requirements of the student's declared degree major, certificate and/or transfer objective, as specified in the college catalog, caused the student to enroll in courses that exceeded the 80 degree-applicable unit maximum.
- 2) Program prerequisites, as specified in the college catalog, caused the student to exceed the 80 degree-applicable unit maximum.
