## <u>Agreement</u>

With this agreement, entered into between East Los Angeles College and Whittier College, you are guaranteed admission to Whittier College provided that you satisfactorily complete all of the requirements listed below and file an application while the University is still accepting applications for \_\_\_\_\_\_semester, 20\_\_\_\_\_. Fall/Spring

Your eligibility requirements include the following:

- a. The student must submit a completed application for admission as well as all supporting documents and the application fee to Whittier College on or before the transfer application deadline (April 15 for fall and December 1 for spring).
- b. The student will have completed the Freshman Writing Seminar requirement and the Quantitative Reasoning requirement with a C grade or better in each class (See the general articulation agreement for courses that will fulfill these requirements).
- c. The student will have completed at least 30 transferable units with a C or better.
- d. The student must have earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in courses eligible for transfer. For example, if a student earned a D or below in a transferable course, that course would not be accepted for transfer credit, but would be factored into the cumulative transfer grade point average.
- e. Students who are admitted with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above will receive a merit-based scholarship ranging from \$10,500 to \$13,500 per year to be used toward tuition at Whittier College. Students who submit a FAFSA and are eligible for need-based aid may also receive Whittier College grants, as well as other state and federal funding.
