This short term certificate program will train individuals to fill specific health IT workforce roles identified by the Office of National Coordination (ONC) for Health Information Technology. East Los Angeles College will direct its initial efforts in training health and IT professionals in the role of Technical/Software Support Staff. This role has been designated as one needed for permanent ongoing support of health IT that has been deployed in office practices, hospitals, health centers, long-term care facilities, health information exchange organizations and state and local public health agencies.
