UCLA CCCP

Students participated in a three week summer residential program held at UCLA. This program works to increase transfer rates and the success of our students by equipping them with the skills and knowledge to the transfer process, while empowering them to become self-advocates and leaders in their communities.



UC Irvine Summer Transfer Experience

Students experienced a free six day summer residential program held at the University of California, Irvine campus. This program is designed to prepare low income, underrepresented students to be competitive applicants when transferring to a four-year institution.

URSA is a free ten day residential program at Loyola Marymount University. It aims to create a transfer pipeline for high achieving, first generation community college students. Students developed research skills alongside ELAC and LMU faculty. Students were paired with a faculty and graduate mentor and received college transfer support.
