**APPLY FOR THE WASHINGTON D.C. INTERNSHIP PROGRAM (DCIP) FOR AN OPPORTUNITY TO WORK AT THE SMITHSONIAN INSTITUTION OR NATIONAL GALLERY OF ART DURING THE WINTER 2023!**

## The DCIP includes:

- Month-long, full-time internship at Smithsonian Institution or National Gallery of Art in Washington D.C..
- Week-long intern orientation include guest speaker presentations and museum visits in Los Angeles, CA.
- Program accommodations at no-cost include: airfare, lodging, and stipend
- Hands-on work experience and one-to-one mentorship.
- Access to professional development events and networking opportunities.

## DCIP Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be a currently enrolled ELAC Student.
- Applicant must be must be authorized to work in the United States. This includes: US Citizens, Green Card holders, DACA recipients, and international students.
- Applicant must be able to travel domestically.
- Applicant must be able to enroll in ELAC Course *Art 385: Directed Study* (3 units) in Winter 2023.
- Applicant must be available for internship from January 3, 2023 – February 3, 2023.
