


ELAC Learning Outcomes 3-Year Assessment Cycle

LAC recommends to reaffirm the 3-year Course-level Assessment Cycle and to accept this graphical representation as the college's official representation of our current 3-year Cycle.



Recommendation for Academic Senate to reaffirm the following *Policies*:

- That each course must **Close the Loop** on all CLOs within a 3-year timespan based on the CLO process described in the diagram. (M/S/P: Aug. 26, 2015)
- The assessment method for each CLO must be an **Authentic Assessment** embedded within the class that carries weight in the grade for the course.

Department Assessment Plans

The **Department Assessment Plan** ensures that each course must **Close the Loop** on all CLOs within a 3-year timespan, and that each discipline publish its schedule for completing the three-year assessment cycle.

The LAO recommends to adopt the following *procedures*:

- To adhere to the **3-year Assessment Cycle** policy, departments must maintain the established **Department Assessment Plan**,
- To ensure accessibility by the public, **Department Assessment Plans** are based on the following Key:

KEY

Step 1: Develop/Revise CLOs & Assessment Methods;

Step 2: Assess (First Time);

Step 3: Analyze the Results and Create an Improvement Plan (discipline-level action plan);

Step 4: Implement Plan;

Step 5: Re-Assess (Second Time);

Step 6: *Close the Loop;* Analyze the Results and Create an Improvement Plan (programlevel action plan).
