Please bring this form with you to your first lesson. Make sure that you both read this before signing at the bottom. Once you both have signed and dated the form, please make TWO photocopies (one for each of you for your records), and submit the ORIGINAL copy to Dr. Nagatani.

MONTHLY ATTENDANCE REPORT FORM

There will be four to five of these forms that you must submit each semester, one at the end of each month. This form requires both your and your private teacher's signatures after every lesson. This ensures that you receive eight full hours of one-on-one instruction per semester, and that your private teacher gets paid for those eight hours.

Unless your teacher agrees to keep it with them, you must bring this form to every lesson. Please submit this completed form to Dr. Nagatani <u>at the end of each month</u>, and print out a new form for each successive new month.

STUDENT PROGRESS REPORT FORM
