Students in the Animation program will acquire and demonstrate animation skills necessary to communicate effectively through visual means. Students will create and implement a variety of animation techniques in order to develop a filmic concept.

Career and Transfer Opportunities

Students are encouraged to pursue further studies at the BA and MA level. However, with a good portfolio, students graduating with an AA from ELAC, can find employment in the following area: modeler, character artist, environment artist, CG generalist, layout artist concept artist, storyboard artist, animator, visual designer, character designer, environment designer, DG production assistant, CG coordinator, rigger, cinematic animator, motion graphics artist, motion graphics designer, scientific visualization real time visualization, architectural rendering, visualization.
