HOW TO JOIN EOPS

STEP 1: SUBMIT AN ONLINE APPLICATION





- full time status of 12 or more units
- DSPS students welcomed and may qualify for reduced units
- be 18 years old or a high school graduate
- received the 2021-2022 financial aid BOG waiver (BOG A or B)
- must be a California resident for one year and one day or AB540
- have completed the A-O-C process

 has not exceeded 70 or more degree applicable units (includes other non-LACCD colleges and universities and units of credit coursework in any combination of postsecondary higher education institutions)

All new students must submit an EOPS application.
Our EOPS staff will review your application to
see if you qualify!



STEP 2: ATTEND ONLINE EOPS ORIENTATION

All APPROVED students will be notified via LACCD student email and/or text message.

If your EOPS application is considered pending for further review, an EOPS staff member will also be reaching you via LACCD student email and/or phone call or text message.

EOPS orientation will present what the program is about, what we offer every semester, and how to stay on track academically!

STAGE 3: MUTUAL RESPONSIBILITY CONTRACT All students must adhere to all EOPS requirements

- PVR (progress verification report)
- Minimum 2.0 GPA per semester

STAGE 4: BOOK GRANT, PRIORITY REGISTRATION & MORE!

If you complete all of your requirements semester after semester, you are guaranteed the book grant and priority registration. If you do not complete said requirements, a lapse of services may occur. Staff can help review your eligibility.
