#### **Department Advising Notes:**

If a student places out of any core course(s) and is not awarded units for that course, the student will need to take additional units to compensate for the course/units required to reach at least 18 total units in the major. Students may choose any additional course(s) from List A or from other approved substitutions to compensate for loss of units. For example, students who are placed out of lower levels of Spanish into a more advanced level, either by the department or through Advanced Placement credit, must take additional courses to meet the minimum 18 unit requirement.

#### **Program Description**

The Associate in Arts in Spanish for Transfer degree is appropriate for students, including bilingual individuals, who wish to continue mastering their language and overall communication skills in Spanish, demonstrating effective skills in reading, writing, speaking and listening comprehension.

#### **Career and Transfer Opportunities**

Students have successfully transferred to UCLA, UC Irvine, UC Berkeley, UC Davis and Cal State universities. In addition to career opportunities for teaching, interpreting and translating students who complete a degree in Spanish have endless career opportunities in government, the entertainment industry, the medical field, the field of law, to name a few.
