#### **CANCELLED CLASSES:**

The Community Services Department reserves the right to cancel any class that has insufficient enrollment before the starting date. Students are notified of the cancellation and given the option to receive a full refund, transfer to another class, or receive account credit (valid for a year, toward future registrations). There is no service charge for classes that are cancelled by the department.

#### **DROPS / TRANSFERS:**

There are no refunds or transfers after a class begins. Requests to withdraw from a class or transfer to another Community Services class must be done 3 OR MORE DAYS prior to the first class meeting. You may notify ELAC Community Services of cancellation by phone, in person, or by e-mail. Unfortunately, you are not able to cancel a registration yourself online. 




