The **Men's Healing Circle** is a safe space where men can come together to process life issues, sexual trauma, child trauma and help them discover tools for stress relief and selfhealing.


The circle opens the door to their inner wisdom and truth, which will help ease inner wounds, and invite success in relationships, career and personal life.


