LACCD GE meets the general education requirements for local Associate Degrees (AA/AS) only. Review the catalog for the list of degrees. Associate Degree Requirements (Administrative Procedures 4100)

Unit Requirement: A minimum of 60 units total (semester, degree applicable)

Scholastic Requirement: A minimum "C" (2.0) cumulative GPA from the courses being used to meet the degree requirements.

Residency Requirement: A minimum of 12 semester units earned from the Los Angeles Community College District colleges.

General Education: A minimum of 27 semester/36 quarter units of GE coursework from the areas below; completed with a "D-" or better.

Major Requirement: All courses counted towards the major must be completed with a "C" (2.0) or better or a "P" if taken Pass/No Pass.
